Professional Development

Utah NAHRO offers relevant training and an annual conference designed *specifically* for housing and community development professionals. These sessions provide education, information and tools to support affordable housing and healthy communities. **Members attending NAHRO sponsored trainings saved approximately \$300-\$700 per training.** Utah NAHRO has also sponsored the Homeless Summit, Utah Housing Coalition’s Housing Matters Conference and Utah Housing Corporation’s REAC training.

Advocacy

Utah NAHRO is committed to representing your interests at the state and national level.
